AN AMERICAN TREASURE...

In 1668, merchant and ship-owner John Turner built a house on Salem Harbor that was destined to become one of America's most beloved historic homes. Designated a National Historic Landmark District in 2007, The House of the Seven Gables is best known today as the setting of world-renowned American author Nathaniel Hawthorne's 1851 novel.

In 1910, Salem philanthropist Caroline Emmerton restored the house and opened it to the public as a museum, using proceeds from ticket sales specifically to fund settlement work that benefitted immigrant families. Over a century later, The House of the Seven Gables Settlement Association is dedicated to continuing Emmerton's vision. Your membership supports our efforts in preserving our historic campus and providing educational opportunities to newly arrived immigrants.
